

Website Terms & Prototype Disclaimer

Prototype-only terms: no present transaction, no implied legal status, and no bypass of launch controls.

Status notice. Global Food Round is currently an informational prototype and verification-stage project. Public payments and donations are not accepted through the prototype. This document sets intended controls and launch conditions; it does not state that any supplier, distribution organization, fiscal sponsor, charitable status, tax treatment, license, insurance arrangement, public-fundraising permission, sanctions clearance, or other regulatory approval has been approved unless expressly identified as such.

1. Informational prototype - no present transaction

This website is informational and interactive. It does not currently provide an enabled checkout for public payments or donations. Nothing on the website is an instruction to send funds now, including by email, Slack, bank transfer, cryptocurrency, payment link or another off-site method. Displaying a future funding model, basket amount, allocation percentage or donor-facing interface does not itself create a completed donation, purchase, beneficiary relationship, partnership, agency or contract.

Whether a communication is regulated fundraising or charitable solicitation is determined by applicable law and the actual facts; this disclaimer does not override a law that treats particular communications as solicitation.

2. No charity, tax or receipt representation

The project name, humanitarian purpose and use of words such as donor or funding do not by themselves mean Global Food Round is a registered charity, tax-exempt entity or authorized charitable fundraiser. No tax deduction or charitable receipt is promised. Any future statement about status, deductibility or receipts must be made accurately by or for the actual receiving entity under the law applicable at that time.

3. Geographic and map limitations

Map entries are geographic or project-interface labels only. They do not state a position on sovereignty, recognition, borders or legal status. A destination appearing on the map is not a representation that payment, procurement, shipment, import, export, distribution or fundraising is lawful or operationally available there. Those matters require transaction-specific review before activation.

4. Candidates, verification and third parties

A supplier, organization or other third party may be displayed as a candidate, research example or source of documentary evidence without being approved, endorsed, contracted or partnered. Candidate, Basket Ready, Purchase Documented, Delivery Confirmed, Distribution Report Received and similar labels must be read only according to the evidence standard stated for that label. For Pilot #001, recipient-reported impact figures are not independently verified by Global Food Round unless a separate independent-verification standard has actually been met. Research, contact or display does not create authority or affiliation.

5. Prices, examples and evidence

Illustrative baskets, exchange-rate references, screenshots and historical examples are not current offers, quotations or guarantees unless expressly identified as current and verified. Prices, stock, taxes, fees, exchange rates, delivery capability and legal availability can change. Evidence of purchase is not by itself evidence of final beneficiary distribution.

A retailer invoice, order record or retailer-recorded card charge may support the state "Purchase Documented" but is not represented as independent bank, card-issuer or payment-processor verification unless that separate evidence is actually retained.

6. Intellectual property, privacy and documentary material

Third-party copyrights, trademarks, confidentiality interests and privacy rights remain with their respective holders. Possession or redaction of material does not by itself establish an unrestricted publication right. Documentary display should have a supportable permission, license or other applicable legal basis. Third-party retailer and organization names are used for factual identification only; unless expressly stated, no endorsement, sponsorship, affiliation or commercial partnership is claimed. 7. Volunteer role and authority

Volunteer research creates research leads and supporting information only. A volunteer has no authority merely by volunteering to fundraise, receive or handle donations, access financial credentials, purchase goods, sign or negotiate agreements, approve or verify a distribution organization, promise business or funding, or otherwise bind Global Food Round. Limited factual initial contact may be permitted only within an expressly assigned research scope.

This website does not itself determine whether any person is legally eligible to volunteer. Participation by a person under the applicable age of majority may occur only after the project has approved an age-appropriate safeguarding process for the relevant location and activity and any consent or permission required by applicable law has been obtained. Until such a process is implemented, the disabled website forms do not constitute acceptance of a minor into the program.

8. Privacy and submissions

Website volunteer and candidate submissions are paused. The previously published Idealist opportunity is now hidden on Idealist and is not presented as an active Global Food Round applicant-intake channel. That hidden status should be maintained during this pause. New formal volunteer or candidate intake should remain paused until the legally responsible controller is identified and the required collection-time notice is provided.

Slack and general contact may remain available for community or general communication only. They must not be presented or used as substitute formal application channels during the pause, and users should not be asked to send identity documents, beneficiary records, payment credentials, health information or other unnecessary sensitive personal information through them. Personal information actually received remains subject to applicable law.

9. Future funding conditions

Verification alone is not sufficient to open public funding. Before public funding is enabled, the actual legal recipient or fiscal sponsor, authority to receive funds, fundraising or solicitation requirements, payment route, receipt responsibility, fees, allocation and reallocation rules, substitutions, failed or blocked transactions, unused funds, sanctions holds, refunds/cancellations, chargebacks, privacy, tax status and legally required disclosures must be resolved for the actual launch structure.
